



# The Woodlands 52, New Caney 0

The Highlanders clinched their 30<sup>th</sup> consecutive playoff spot with a 52-0 shutout over New Caney. The win improves the Highlanders' all-time record over the Eagles to 12-1. The Woodlands has now won 4 straight games by a combined score of 232-34.

Quarterback Jack Daulton got the Highlanders on the board first with a 13-yard touchdown pass to Jason Haskins. Daulton would later add two touchdown passes to Jackson Bolender and a 27-yard TD run. The quarterback finished 12-13 passing for 128 yards and 3 TDs.

Running Back Lincoln Halsey had the biggest play of the night with a highlight-reel 76-yard touchdown run on the Highlanders' second drive of the night.

All-purpose player Cadriel Outlaw took a handoff and then pulled up to throw a 25-yard TD pass to Preston Stephenson late in the 1<sup>st</sup> half to bring the score to 35-0 before the break.

The Highlanders continued to dominate the game in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. Quarterback Parker Stephenson hit Kimou Kouletsis for a touchdown and Scott Starzyk added a 25-yard field goal. In total, The Woodlands racked up 476 yards of offense.

On the defensive side of the ball, safety Caycen Bartolazzi had 2 interceptions to bring his season-total to 5. Drew Honeyman and Ben Bridges each recorded 8 tackles. As a unit, the defense held the Eagles to just 150 yards of total offense and earned their second shutout of the season.
